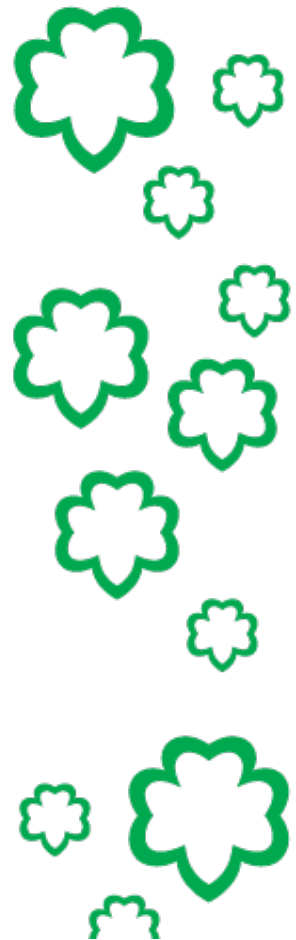

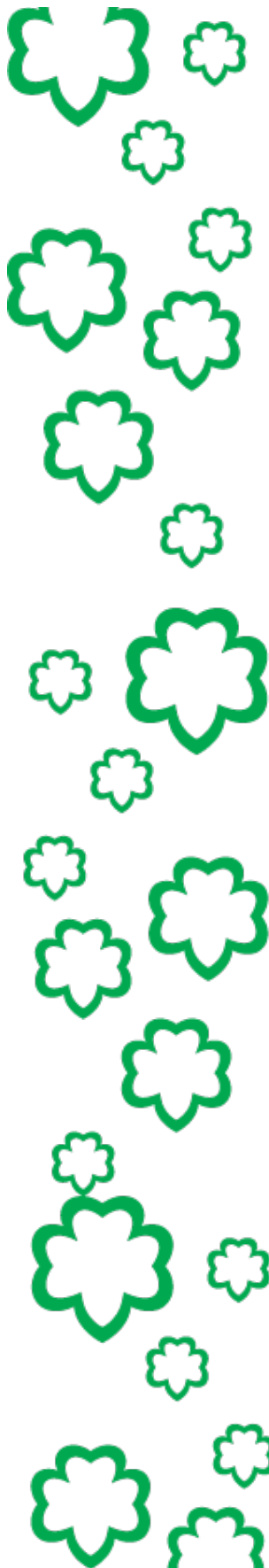

Madame Tussauds DC Honors Juliette Gordon Low with Wax Figure

On May 9, with a month left until *Girl Scouts Rock the Mall*, The Presidents Gallery by Madame Tussauds launched Juliette Gordon Low's wax figure. The launch took place as part of a series of initiatives celebrating the Girl Scouts' anniversary, culminating with the colossal *Girl Scouts Rock the Mall: 100th Anniversary Sing-Along* event on June 9.



Madame Tussauds studio artists in London worked diligently to create this entirely new wax figure of Juliette Gordon Low. The figure-making process is incredibly intricate taking anywhere from three to six months from start to finish. In order to make the figures as lifelike as possible, Madame Tussauds artists study hundreds of photographs and when available, hours of video footage. An expert on Juliette Gordon Low was brought in to make sure everything was historically accurate.

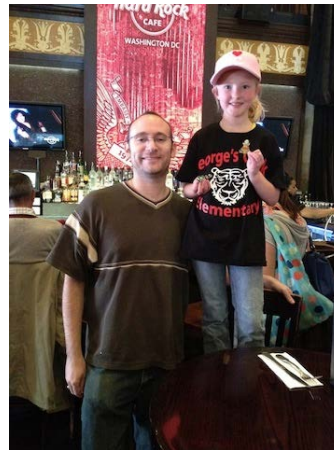
