



Transportation for Individuals with Mobility Needs

Please note – the National Park Service and the DC Metropolitan Police Department will **NOT** allow general vehicle unloading at or near the monument grounds.

Travelers with mobility needs should register (<https://register.gscnc.org/Apps/RockTheMall/>) and indicate their access needs as soon as possible. These travelers will be directed to one of three Metro stations in downtown Washington, DC for pick up by a GSCNC Accessible Shuttle that will drop them off directly at the Washington monument grounds. Adults with access needs will be permitted to travel with their child and one buddy. Children will be permitted to travel with a buddy and a chaperone/troop leader.

These shuttles will run from the stations to the Washington Monument from 8 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and again from 3 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.

The stations were selected to accommodate passengers traveling from all Metro lines and travelers who will be dropped off by vehicle at the GSCNC Accessible Shuttle pick up/drop off points.

Those Metro stations include:

- Gallery Place/Chinatown (7th & F Streets, NW)
- Metro Center (12th & F Streets, NW)
- Farragut North (1001 Connecticut Ave, NW)
